

Questions to you the reader:

These are three simple questions that you can ask anyone and everyone, and see just how many people can actually answer these questions successfully, because you may just find that not many people can.

Q-1: Do you know what the 'Supreme Law' of the United States of America is?

(**Hint:** It is the same law that is the foundation of the structure of our government and it is the law that all other laws **MUST** conform to and not to be in violation of. And it is the law that **ALL** public officials must follow and adhere to from the President, to the Congress, and to the Judiciary.)

Answers to the questions:

A-1: The '**Supreme Law**' of the United States is the **U.S. Constitution** which was adopted in 1781 by unanimous agreement by the original thirteen colonies which became states and each of the territories that became states that joined the Union thereafter.

A-2: The part of the '**Supreme Law U.S. Constitution**' that recognizes and guarantees your rights as granted only by God is called 'The Bill of Rights'. An these are the first ten amendments to the Constitution. The original thirteen colonies refused to approve the Constitution unless these particular amendments were added to guarantee that the Federal Government to be formed would not eventually devolve to become a despotic tyrannical form of government that would violate the God-given rights of Liberty which are derived from Natural Law for the people. And Your Rights Are Protected by this same LAW.

A-3: It is '**WE-THE-PEOPLE**' who own each and every one of OUR governments as it states prominently in—and as the very first phrase in our '**Supreme Law U.S. Constitution**'. And it is '**WE-THE-PEOPLE**', not 'We The Politicians' or 'We The Government Officials'. AND it is '**WE-THE-PEOPLE**' who have paid for it through our tax dollars, and who many of US have also served and paid for it to protect our Constitutional Republic, our homes, and our LIBERTY with our blood, sweat and tears, our limbs, and our very LIVES throughout US history and up until this very time!
